On May 19th we are hosting the 1st District Corn Hole Tournament. We're hoping to get as many teams from the

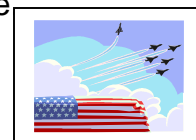
post as we can. There are entry forms on the board so lets get some teams together and win this thing.

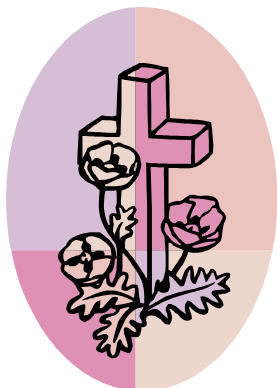

need teams. There will be more information in your May News Letter.

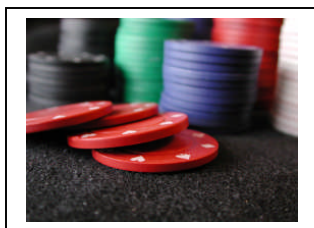
Monte Carlo – Mike Mullins

Motorcycle Riders News

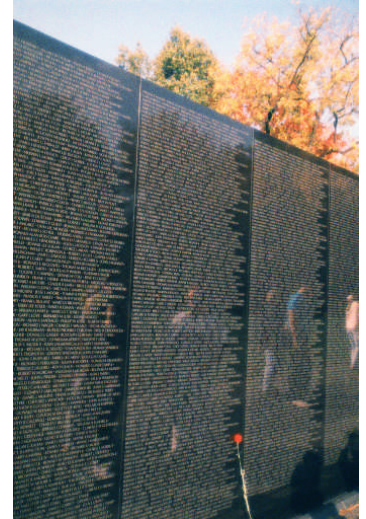
